RESEARCH APPLICATION

Woodson Research Center is pleased to provide access to its manuscript and archive holdings. Permission to examine the records held in the Center will normally be granted to researchers upon completion of this application.

Guidelines for using non-circulating materials:

1. Researchers must sign in and out at the register upon each visit to the Center, and must provide current photo identification before any materials are retrieved. Identification will be held until materials are returned and inspected.
2. Backpacks, briefcases, personal reference books and notebooks may be subject to inspection when leaving the Center.
3. Smoking, drinking and eating are not permitted; use of cellular phones is prohibited.
4. Pencils must be used; gloves when required.
5. Please keep all records in the present arrangement and use only one folder at a time. Make no marks or erasures on any document. Researchers will be allowed to use only two boxes at a time.
6. Theft, destruction or mutilation of the materials is a crime.
7. Photocopying is permitted if in accordance with donor agreement and copyright restrictions; permission must be granted for all photoduplication requests. **Researchers assume sole responsibility for any infringement of literary rights, copyrights, or other rights pertaining to the materials.**
8. Citations should follow the format of: **Name of collection, Woodson Research Center, Fondren Library, Rice University.**
9. The use of certain materials is restricted by Rice University, by reason of origin, or by donor contract. For the protection of its collections, the Center also reserves the right to restrict the use of records which are not yet arranged or are in the process of being arranged, or are records of exceptional value or fragility.
10. Woodson Research Center is an educational research facility working to preserve Rice University's special collections of rare books, manuscripts and university archives. We welcome your assistance through donations, which would enhance our collections.
